### OUTDOOR PERFORMANCE

A full stunt show performance will require a bare **minimum of 75' x 150'**. Depending on the venue and how many people will be in attendance, **I would prefer up to 100' x 200'**; this gives me the opportunity to ride longer wheelies during my performance! Many locations actually use an adjacent street and seek permission from the City to have it blocked off for the performance.

### INDOOR PERFORMANCE

All indoor stunt show performances are abbreviated for numerous reasons and require a **minimum of 50' x 75'**. This does not take into account the space needed for my **booth**, which will add an **additional 10' x 20' min** to display all of the stunt and performance units. **Most importantly, I need a minimum door width of 48"** to get my widest unit through.

### NON-PERFORMANCE (SPEAKING ONLY) | CHURCH | APP PROGRAM (with full display of stunt units)

A speaking only engagement with a full display of stunting equipment. **Requires a 10' x 20' area.**

## Jackson attempts wheelie record

**EASTLAND** - It's easy to take a wrong turn, especially if you're unsure of where you're going. But Bryan Jackson says he has an APP for that, and it ain't GPS. "You know, I want to encourage kids," he said. "I have a program I call APP that stands for Attitude, Purpose and Passion."

Jackson is something of a celebrity not just in Eastland but around the country. A past motocross champion, he is celebrating his 50th year on motorcycles with a special stunt show honoring the late "Wheelie King" Doug Domokos. "He was killed the year our ministry started, which was in 2007," Jackson said. "He performed in 26 countries and set crazy world records like riding a wheelie for 145 miles or wheeling around the walkway on the Empire State Building."

Jackson founded Vertical Adventure Motocross Ministries with his wife Tina, mixing a Christian message with a motocross stunt show. On April 28, Jackson brought his show home to Eastland with a late-afternoon performance at River of Life Church.

Earlier in the day, he performed a pace-down version of it for Eastland schools. "To some extent I do motivational speaking with the program that I developed," he said. "It's all part of the ministry, and of course with the schools we only go so far with that. He had already performed for elementary school students earlier in the day when I caught up with him before the middle school show. The school partners with us to do a free program, to where it doesn't cost the school anything," Jackson said. "Our intent is to try to get kids and families to church tonight to where we don't have any restrictions with the spiritual side of what we are doing."

Once the auditorium filled, Jackson appeared wearing red, white and blue motocross leathers and began speaking. It likely wasn't the first time these kids had seen him and they responded with cheers when he raised his arms in the air.

He keeps the message simple. "Just not to get lost," he explained. "That's the main message, especially with the older kids. We're trying to encourage them not to lose focus and valuable time in those delicate years." He punctuates his message by climbing down off the stage to start up his motorcycle, warning everyone to plug their ears first. Harley Head, 14, was in the first row right in front of the bike. Perhaps named after a motorcycle, it didn't seem like she was into them as much as her parents might have been. "Yeah, my dad did motorcycles when he was, like, younger," she confirmed. "But he's old now." Her friend Emily Hooper, 13, laughed as everyone else plugged their ears. "Because it was funny!" she explained, giggling again. "And scary at the same time!" chimed in Stormy Owen, 14, from three seats down. Jackson retook the stage after that and brought out his modified three-wheeler. He rode a continuous wheelie the length and breadth of the stage, spoke a few minutes more, then thanked the kids for their attention and ended the show.

The highlight of the evening's performance outside the church was going to be Jackson's attempt at a new Guinness world record: "I am going to wheelie up a 20-foot long ramp that's between 20 and 25 degrees to the top of my trailer, over and across, and then down another 20-to-25-degree ramp," Jackson explained. "Of course doing all that with the front wheel off the ground the entire time, on my three-wheeler." Jackson said it's never been attempted. The entire thing would be recorded from multiple angles with the church pastors serving as witnesses to the stunt. "It's exciting because of the machinery, and in the balance and the skill that it takes," said Dusty Messenger, Jackson's mechanic. He modified the three-wheeler so it can be steered using a series of specially-placed brake actuators on the rear wheels.

As the shadows lengthened, Jackson warmed up the crowd of mostly teens, tweens and parents. Children chased after as he wheelied to the street, and they lined up to watch him ride backwards on a motorcycle and then a scooter. When the big moment came, Jackson wheelied the three-wheeler up a ramp to the top of his trailer, slowed momentarily, then continued the same way down on the other end. Presumably it was a success, the crowd certainly thought so, but a final confirmation will come later from Guinness.

"It's just weird, I blame all this stuff on the genes of my family," Jackson admitted, laughing. "The heritage of motorcycles in my family goes back to 1920 when my grandmother and grandfather started riding their own motorcycles. He learned to ride at age 5, when his feet couldn't even reach the ground. That family tradition continues, too."

Jackson's 4-year-old grandson Landon accompanied him on a scooter that evening, also riding backwards. Dressed-out in full motocross gear just like his grandpa, Landon kept a tight grip and determined face the whole time. A bumper spacer placed between the handlebars sums up Jackson's philosophy. It paraphrases the Bible's James 4:14, "Enjoy it, tomorrow is uncertain." "It's something I try to live by, in the grand scheme of things we really do have a short time here," Jackson explained. "It seems like the older we get, the faster time seems to go."

On April 1, 2019, Bryan Jackson, Founder of Vertical Adrenaline Motocross Ministries, did a motorcycle wheelie for 10.62 miles at an average of 9.9 mph. It is the longest- slowest motorcycle wheelie ever recorded and was done on his Doug Domokos Tribute USA Made ATK 250cc dirt bike. The feat was done non-stop without any feet on the ground and was Performed in Eastland Texas, USA, beginning on the north Interstate 20 access road, Exit 340, to crossover bridge towards Cisco Texas to County Road 177, then back east, on the south Interstate 20 access road, to exit 340.
